- 3. How have your actions benefitted the community as a whole?

Dorothy A. Seegers Memorial Award

Awarded annually in honor of Dorothy A. Seegers, who made a significant contribution to Temple University from 1943 to 1979 as a student, employee, and administrator. The award is given to a fulltime graduating senior who has demonstrated a concern for others and has shown dedication and loyalty to Temple University.
